## Summer Garden BoM March 2023 - Jack's Delight

March features the Jack's Delight block; a beginner friendly block with a design that's set on point. It consists of squares, half square triangles, and bias-cut triangles.

Block instructions use the two at a time half-square triangle construction method introduced in October and uses biassewn seams as introduced in January.

As mentioned in the September fabric requirements PDF, this block requires the following;

For a throw sized quilt:
Background - 2 fat quarters OR 0.4m yardage
Fabric A - 1 fat quarter OR 0.15m yardage
Fabric B-1 fat quarter OR 0.15m yardage

For a twin sized quilt:
Background - 4 fat quarters OR 0.8m yardage
Fabric A - 2 fat quarters OR 0.3m yardage
Fabric B-1 fat quarter OR 0.15m yardage

For a queen sized quilt:
Background - 6 fat quarters OR 1.1m yardage
Fabric A - 2 fat quarters OR 0.4m yardage
Fabric B - 2 fat quarters OR 0.3m yardage

To make a quilt similar to the original sample design, use a medium green background, pink fabric A, and white fabric B.

## Jack's Delight Cutting Instructions:

To make 1 block, cut the following:

Background - 2 x squares at $6 \frac{1}{4}$ ", cut in half diagonally to make $4 x$ triangles
$7 x$ squares at $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
$2 x$ squares at $2^{\prime \prime}$

Fabric $A-7 x$ squares at $21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$, draw a diagonal line on the back of each

Fabric B-1x square at $5^{\prime \prime}$
Jack's Delight Assembly Instructions:

Select one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background square and one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ fabric A square. Place them right sides together and stitch $1 / 4$ " on either side of the drawn line.


Cut along the drawn line to make two half square triangles.
Trim to 2" square.
Make 14.

Using the 14 half square triangle units, two 2" background squares, and the 5 " square of fabric B, assemble the centre unit of the block as shown below.


Select one $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background triangle. Sew the long edge of the triangle to one edge of the centre unit, aligning them in the middle. Note that the corners of the background triangle will extend beyond the corners of the centre unit.


Repeat with the remaining three background triangles.


Trim block to $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " square.

For a lap quilt, make 4.
For a twin quilt, make 9.
For a queen quilt, make 14.
